

NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILL CITY COUNCIL VACANCY BY APPOINTMENT

The City of George, Lyon County, Iowa, has a vacancy on the city council as of December 9, 2020, due to the passing of Larry Thoelke. Larry was appointed on January 10, 2019 and then elected as city council member which he began serving in the capacity on January 1, 2020.

Pursuant to Section 372.13, (2), (a) of the Code of Iowa, notice is hereby given that the City Council of George, Lyon County, Iowa, intends to fill this vacancy by appointment during their next regular council meeting that will be held at George Community Room at 7:00 PM on Thursday, January 14, 2021. However, the electors of the City of George have the right to file a petition requiring that the vacancy be filled by a special election. If electors wish to require a special election, a valid petition requesting a special election must be filed with the city clerk within fourteen (14) days after publication of this notice or within fourteen (14) days after the appointment is made. If no such petition is filed, the appointment shall be for the period until the next pending election as defined in Section 69.12 of the Code of Iowa

Eligible electors of the City of George, Lyon County, Iowa, wanting to be considered for appointment should submit a request in writing to the city clerk's office by 4:00 PM on Friday, January 8, 2021. (standard forms are available at the city office or the library)
