### 7 Steps for Source Water Protection

1. Organize a Source Water Team
2. Identify Capture Zones
3. Inventory Contaminant Sources
4. Prioritize Contaminant Sources
5. Develop an Action Plan
6. Emergency Response Plan
7. Submit and Implement SWP Plan

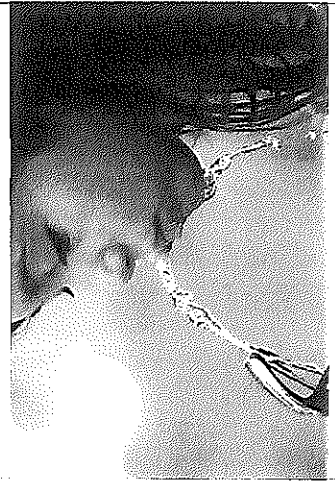
