ORDINANCE NO. 259

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE IV TRAFFIC AND STREETS; CHAPTER 3: SIDEWALKS; ARTICLE 20.20 PERMIT REQUIRED

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GEORGE, IOWA

SECTION I. ENACTMENT. The City Code of the City of George, Title IV Traffic and Streets; Chapter 3: Sidewalks; Article 20.20 Permit Required is amended by repealing Article 20.20 Permit Required and replacing it with the following text as a new Article 20.20 Permit Required as follows:

20.20 <u>PERMIT REQUIRED</u>. No person shall remove or install a sidewalk unless such person has obtained a permit from the City and has agreed in writing that said removal or installation will comply with all ordinances and requirements of the City for such work. If the removal or installation of a sidewalk is related to the reconstruction or repair of an existing sidewalk, the application and fee requirement shall be waived. However, if the footprint of the sidewalk is altered and/or enlarged during reconstruction and/or repair then an application and fee are required. An applicant shall submit to the City Clerk the application and fee prior to beginning work. The cost of the permit shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

SECTION II. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provisions or parts of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any action, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION IV. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
