## **SPECIAL MEETING**

The George City Council met in special session on Monday, March 6, 2023 in the Community Room, 115 S Main Street, 120 S Main Street, with Mayor Billy Sprock presiding. Mayor Sprock called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m. The roll was called by Mayor Sprock. Present were: Ande Bruinsma, Stacy Denekas, Bob Gruis, Warren Tiedeman and Carola Vivian. Absent: none.

Tiedeman made a motion to adopt the agenda. Vivian seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

Council reviewed the proposed addition of critical care to the employee policy. Denekas made a motion to add critical care to the policy for full-time employees paid by the city. Gruis seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

Discussion regarding the 30kw Generac Diesel Generator at the Wells. Gruis made a motion for Siebring Electric Company to purchase a Winco PSS-30 Generator in the amount of \$25,000. This generator will run on propane or natural gas instead of the diesel and will be easier to maintain. Vivian seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

Council discussed and reviewed street, sewer and water maps with Michael Carr and Gary Kurth, DGR Engineers. After discussion on priority locations the engineers will draft up prices for the projects.

Council reviewed Matt Michell's bids for storm sewer work on Hamilton Street. Council requested a 15" drainage tube be installed instead of the proposed 12" tube

Next regular council meeting will be held on March 8, 2023 at 7:00 p.m.

Denekas made a motion to adjourn at 7:07 p.m. Tiedeman seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.
