

## SPECIAL MEETING

The George City Council met in special session on Monday, June 26, 2023 in the Community Room, 115 S Main Street, 120 S Main Street, with Mayor Billy Sprock presiding. Mayor Sprock called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m. The roll was called by Mayor Sprock. Present were: Ande Bruinsma, Bob Gruis, Warren Tiedeman and Carola Vivian. Guest: Lucius Johnson

Tiedeman made a motion to adopt the agenda. Vivian seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

Fred Landis, Kiwanis representative met with the council to discuss the relocation of the can cribs. The recommendation would be to go on the west side of the city shop on Baldwin St. The Kiwanis would pour a cement pad to help eliminate weed problems with the can cribs. Council would like a draft up an agreement with Kiwanis that the responsibility of the can cribs will be Kiwanis and not the city. Vivian made a motion to accept the recommendation to move the can cribs to city property. Bruinsma seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

Council reviewed more bids for a lawn mower purchase. Tabled.

Council reviewed the bids for a new pond fountain. Council asked if the lights from the old fountain would be interchangeable with the new fountain. Clerk will check with the company.

Council discussed getting a different lift for the city. Vivian made a motion to purchase a SkyJack SJ40T from Eben Construction in the amount of \$27,500. Gruis seconded the motion to purchase. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

Council reviewed quotes to purchase a new speed display trailer. Tabled.

Council reviewed quotes to purchase a new pool vacuum. Tabled.

Vivian made a motion to purchase the booster pump for the swimming pool in the amount of \$1150. Bruinsma seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

Gruis made a motion to purchase a new chlorinator pump for the water plant in the amount of \$1099. Vivian seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.

Gruis introduced the following **Resolution No. 2023-06-395** entitled "RESOLUTION APPROVING TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM CASINO SAVINGS ACCOUNT TO GENERAL CASH ACCOUNT TO OFFSET THE EXPENSES TO INSTALL A GENERATOR AT THE WELLS" and moved that the same be adopted. Tiedeman seconded the motion to adopt. Roll call vote: –ayes: Bruinsma, Gruis, Tiedeman and Vivian, –nays: none. Motion carried.

Next regular council meeting will be held on July 12, 2023 at 7:00 p.m.

Tiedeman made a motion to adjourn at 6:21 p.m. Bruinsma seconded the motion. All present cast aye votes, motion carried.
